RESTRICTIONS

- Students wishing to run for a Council position may only run for a seat that represents their own stream and year of engineering. Similarly, students may not nominate nor vote for Council candidates that will not represent them;
- The number of seats for a particular position represents the maximum number of candidates a student may nominate and/or vote for, for that position;
- In order to run for the position of President, students must have served a full term on Council.
